Description:

Strong stains on car glass, painted surfaces, transparent coatings, tinted films, and other materials can be thoroughly cleaned with this solution's potent acidic mix. Restoring clean, smooth surfaces with just a water rinse makes it easier to use. It rapidly and efficiently removes water spots, stains, and streaks brought on by acid rain and sun exposure. Despite its cleaning ability, the mixture is safe to use and, properly followed, won't harm surfaces.

PH: 2

Ingredients:

Citric acid, surfactant, chelating agent, corrosion inhibitor, deionized water.

Dilution Ratio:

The product can be used straight away and doesn't need to be diluted

Instructions:

- 1. Before cleaning, apply the product onto a sponge, cloth, or detailing brush.
- 2. Rinse thoroughly with clean water immediately after cleaning (for stubborn stains, repeat cleaning).

Caution:

- Wear gloves before using this product.
- Application time must not exceed 2 minutes.
- Do not directly squeeze the solution onto the application area.
- No dry wiping allowed; ensure the application area is kept moist before application.
- Do not use in direct sunlight or on hot paint surfaces and glass.
- Water stains or corrosion caused by AC condensation cannot be removed; polishing or repainting is required.
- Keep out of reach of children.

Restrict Area:

Plated parts, chrome trim, rearview mirrors, worn or aged glass and paint surfaces.

WARNING:
