Description:

The surface degreaser is an important pre-treatment for coating, polishing, and wrapping because it rapidly removes excess oil and wax from automotive surfaces. In addition to efficiently dissolving oil and impurities, its pH-neutral A13 formula serves as a conditioner for microfiber towels and restoring the softness of the fibers.

PH: 7

Ingredients:

Penetrants, wetting agents, surfactants, deionized water

Dilution Ratios:

The product can be used straight away and doesn't need to be diluted.

Instructions:

After completing the paint treatment, spray this product onto the car paint surface. Allow the oil stains to naturally emulsify, then wipe clean with a soft towel. For areas not suitable for direct spraying, spray onto the towel first and wipe the surface, then wash the towel thoroughly and wring dry. Finally, wipe the surface again with a damp towel.

Caution:

- Keep out of reach of children.In case of accidental contact with eyes or ingestion, rinse thoroughly with water and seek medical attention immediately.
- Do not store in high-temperature areas or under direct sunlight.
- This product may contain slight sedimentation, which is normal and does not affect its performance.
- This product is for industrial cleaning use only; do not misuse it.
