Description:

A5 cleans deeper than washing or claying alone by forming a water-soluble complex with iron particles that are stuck to the surface and allowing them to be rinsed off. It can be applied to wheels, paint and plastic. The chromogenic agent provides real-time indication for complete removal of ferrous particulates.

Ingredients:

Deionized Water, Surfactant, Iron Indicator, Triethanolamine, Casone

Dilution Ratio:

600ml: The product can be used straight away and doesn't need to be diluted. **5L:**

- Hand pressure sprayer:1:1 (or undiluted)
- Spray Bottle: 1:1 (or undiluted)

Instructions:

- 1. Spray on and wait 30 seconds.
- 2. After dissolution, there will be a noticeable flow of purple liquid.
- 3. Rinse thoroughly to clean.

Caution:

- Keep out of reach of children. In case of accidental contact with eyes or ingestion, rinse thoroughly with water and seek medical attention immediately.
- Do not store in high-temperature areas or under direct sunlight.
- This product may contain slight sedimentation, which is normal and does not affect its performance.
- This product is for industrial cleaning use only; do not misuse it.
