Description:

It helps prevent ageing and hardening, delivering up to 3 months of durable protection.

Eco-solvent, polydimethoxane, antioxidant

Dilution Ratio:

The product can be used straight away and doesn't need to be diluted.

Instructions:

1. Clean and dry tires before using.
2. The agent should be squeezed onto the waxing sponge.
3. Make sure the tire surface is completely covered by applying the sponge evenly.
4. Just let it air dry naturally.

Caution:

- **Keep out of reach of children.** In case of accidental contact with eyes or ingestion, rinse thoroughly with water and seek medical attention immediately.
- Do not store in high-temperature areas or under direct sunlight.
- This product may contain slight sedimentation, which is normal and does not affect its performance.
