Description:

The product creates an antifouling and hydrophobic layer (lotus effect) on the surface, protecting it from ageing, dirt and UV radiation, as well as from water spot. A simple spraying and wiping operation ensures a shiny, long-lasting paint surface, while also greatly improving the hydrophobicity and stain resistance.

PH: 7

Ingredients:

Silicone oil, D60 solvent oil, carnauba wax, S wax, deionized water

Dilution Ratio:

The product can be used straight away and doesn't need to be diluted.

Instructions:

- 1. After cleaning and drying the car, evenly apply B7 Pro on the surface.
- 2. Use a clean towel to wipe the surface evenly until it dry.

Caution:

- Keep out of reach of children.
- In case of accidental contact with eyes or ingestion, rinse thoroughly with water and seek medical attention immediately.
- Do not store in high-temperature areas or under direct sunlight.
- This product may contain slight sedimentation, which is normal and does not affect its performance.
